The Student Ministry Intern is a paid position. There are no additional benefits connected with this position. There is no paid vacation time or sick leave. The intern receives the same holidays as the permanent staff. The greatest benefit of this position is not financial, but rather the invaluable ministry experience.

Responsibilities

To provide the greatest benefit to the intern and the church, this is designed as a general ministry internship. We will tailor the internship around your specific field of interest. The intern will seek to do the following:

- Teaching: Provide assistance, support, teaching and/or leadership.
- **Campus Ministry:** Taking God's blessings, his resources, and a timely message to students and their schools.
- **Life Groups:** Create and grow small communities of students who are growing in their relationship with Jesus and others.
- Writing: Contribute articles for the blog or small group materials.
- **Events:** Provide assistance, support, teaching and/or leadership for events, in areas that match the intern's talents and the church's needs.

Feedback

None of these feedback sessions are really formal job evaluations, but rather, informal opportunities for personal growth and mutual reflection.

Supervision

On a day-to-day basis, the Ministry Intern is supervised by the Student Pastor and the Junior High Pastors. Ultimately, the intern reports to the eldership of Southern Hills.
